**SUBJECT : 69TH JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) AND
30TH JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI)**



1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will participate in the **69th Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and 30th Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)** on **October 16–18, 2026**, in coordination with local councils, participating amateur radio clubs, and the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM).
2. The JOTA-JOTI is an annual international Scouting event that provides Scouts and Scout Leaders the opportunity to communicate and connect with fellow Scouts around the world through amateur radio and internet-based platforms, promoting international friendship, fellowship, and understanding.
3. In this regard, the **Philippine Amateur Radio Association, Inc. (PARA)** will assist the BSP in the implementation of the JOTA activities and in the coordination and designation of local amateur radio clubs that will participate in the activity.
4. The special callsign to be used by the Boy Scouts of the Philippines for the 69th Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) shall be **"DX90S."** The callsign carries a special significance, with **"90" representing the 90th Anniversary of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines** and **"S" representing Scouts**.
5. The following arrangements shall be observed:
 - 5.1 Local Councils will be provided with a list of local amateur clubs which they can coordinate with for the JOTA activities within their respective councils, with the assistance and guidance of PARA.
 - 5.2 Amateur Radio Operators, interested professional Scouters, Local Council Executive Boards, and Scout Leaders may participate as volunteers, subject to the applicable BSP policies and coordination with the participating local amateur radio clubs.
 - 5.3 Each Local Council may organize more than one (1) JOTA-JOTI site, as may be necessary, to facilitate the participation of Scouts and Scout Leaders within the Council.

- 5.4 Each Local Council shall designate a **JOTA-JOTI Focal Person** who shall coordinate the participation and management of the JOTA-JOTI site/s within the Council. Kindly use the following link to register the designated JOTA-JOTI Focal Person: <https://bit.ly/BSP-JOTAJOTI-Focal-2026>
- 5.5 Each Local Council shall ensure that a **Safeguarding Officer is available** during the conduct of its JOTA-JOTI activities, in accordance with the BSP Safeguarding Policy. Kindly use the following link to register the designated Safeguarding Officer:

- 5.6 The participation of amateur radio clubs in the **JOTA activities** shall be coordinated with and guided by PARA, particularly on the technical aspects necessary for the implementation of the activity.
- 5.7 All participants shall complete the **SfH 3: Being Safe Online** course prior to registration for the JOTA-JOTI 2026 activity.

6. For the **Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA)**, participating councils and stations are encouraged to coordinate with local amateur radio clubs within their respective areas. The following local frequencies may be used:

7. For the **Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)**, Scouts and Scout Leaders may participate using an internet connection and a computer, tablet, or smartphone. Participants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the official JOTA-JOTI program and participate in the various activities and online engagements.
- 7.1 **Participants should have an active scout.org account** to facilitate access to the various World Scouting platforms, including the JOTA-JOTI Virtual Platform.

The **BSP National Office** will host a **JOTA-JOTI activity** at the **Philippine Christian University (PCU), Manila**, on **October 17, 2026**, as part of the 69th Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and 30th Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI). The activity will provide participating Scouts and Scout Leaders with opportunities to engage in JOTA and JOTI activities and connect with fellow Scouts through amateur radio and internet-based platforms.
9. These arrangements are intended to ensure proper coordination among the BSP, PARA, Local Councils, and participating local amateur radio clubs for the successful implementation of the **69th Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and 30th Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)**.
10. All Regional Youth Development Officers, Council Scout Executives, and Officers-in-Charge are requested to disseminate this Memorandum and encourage the participation of Scouts and Scout Leaders in their respective areas.
